

Welcome to First Grade!

It has been a great year! This summer, to keep the children's skills strong, they will be working on a summer skills packet and a reading log. This should be a good review of the important concepts that were focused on this year, without being a burden on their relaxation and free time. See below for further details.

ELA & Math Packet: Students should complete the attached packet which will focus on the Math and ELA skills they have learned this year. I suggest the children complete one page per day (weekends off) as this is the best way to keep their skills fresh and avoid the "summer slide". This will be turned in the first week of school.

Reading: I encourage your child to read every weekday of the summer for at least 10 minutes—use the reading log at the end of your packet to track your reading.
